MIKIO ARISAWA, Ph.D.

Mikio Arisawa, Ph. D., is the Executive Director of Chugai Academy for Advanced Oncology (CHAAO), a wholly Chugai-sponsored non-profit organization. Before he retired from Chugai Pharmaceuticals in March 2010, he was a Senior Vice President responsible for Research and Early Development.

He joined Research of Roche in 1972, worked on infectious disease, biochemical screening, natural products, and development of antibiotics until 1987. Two years during this period, he worked in Basel Switzerland. In 1987 he became responsible for the operation of Roche Global Screening, in 1993 was assigned to the global Head of Antifungal Discovery, and in 1999 to Head of Oncology in Roche Discovery in Japan. He joined Chugai in 2002 as a Vice President when Nippon Roche and Chugai merged. Since then, he headed Chugai Research until 2010 together with additional responsibility for Technology Development (2004-2005) or Early Development (2005-2010). He held positions of Director of Roche Research in Japan and Executive Board Member of Roche Japan, and Roche Global Research Management Team for five years from 1997.

Dr. Arisawa received Ph. D. in Pharmaceutical Science from The University of Tokyo and Master's degree in Molecular Biology from Nagoya University.
